Swim Times: Friday: 8:00-9:30pm start; finish by 10:30pm

Saturday: 6:00-9:30pm start; finish by 10:30pm

Sunday: 1:00-3:00pm start; finish by 4:00pm

Monday: 2:00-4:00pm start; finish by 5:00pm



Cost: \$3.00 per swim per day. With our 3 swims on each of the 4 days and the NWFT swim, you can achieve up to 13 IVV Swim Events for the weekend!

Participation: Anyone can participate. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Participants will swim or water walk and may rest at the ends of the pool but cannot leave the pool area during the swim events. Participants are required to wear swim attire. It is recommended to come ready to swim & just cover-up afterwards. Limited dressing facilities will be the rest room facilities of Candlewood Suites. The pool will be shared with the guests of Candlewood Suites. Please bring your own towels. **These swim events will be CANCELLED if there is severe weather and/or dangerous swimming conditions.** Event credit will be given to those present.
