If you click on this feature for traditional events, a message appears saying that this feature applies only to YRE/seasonal events.

Start Point: Whidbey General Hospital 101 N. Main, Coupeville. From north or south, take I-5 exit 230 (SR 20/Burlington) and follow SR20 west, following signs to Oak Harbor, then Coupeville, approx. 40 miles. At light in Coupeville, turn left onto North Main Street. Hospital is on right. Start box is podium-sized and located inside the first set of doors at the hospital main entrance.

Open daily, dawn to dusk. Walk along sidewalks, paved roads and gravel paths in the second oldest town in Washington. Pass several Victorian homes and walk through the picturesque town of Coupeville with many views of Penn Cove, the Cascade Mountains and Mt. Baker. The walk is suitable for strollers but there are two very short sections along a main street without sidewalks and one hill on a gravel path. Water, cafeteria and toilets at start/finish. Restaurants and picnic spots along the route. Canadian rating is 2A.

1). To Revise Starting Point Data.
